

**Minutes of a Regular Meeting** of the Town Board of the Town of Thompson held at the Town Hall, 4052 State Route 42, Monticello, New York on **September 16, 2014.**

**PUBLIC HEARING: PROPOSED LOCAL LAW # 5- SICK TIME ACCRUAL FOR NEW EMPLOYEES**

Supervisor Rieber opened the Public Hearing at 7:30 PM. Town Clerk, Marilee J. Calhoun read the legal public notice and stated that she had an original affidavit of publication. Notice of said hearing was duly published in the Sullivan County Democrat on September 05, 2014 with same being posted at the Town Hall on September 03, 2014.

Supervisor Rieber and Attorney Mednick explained that there was a question on the work rules as to whether employees accrued sick leave on a pay period basis or whether the employees had to wait a year to obtain sick leave. All departments in the Town had a previous history of accruing sick leave on a pay period basis. The intent of this law is to clarify that any employee from Day One to accrue one sick day per month with an additional one day at the end of six months and one additional day at the close of 12 months, therefore allowing 14 sick days to be accrued each year.

Supervisor Rieber asked if the Board had any comments. The Board made the following comments:

Councilman Mace stated that he would like to see sick days accrue a little slower for new employees. He thinks 14 days seems like a lot for new employees to get off the first year of employment and he would suggest maybe 7 days for the first year. Councilman Briggs stated that teachers get 15 days. Councilman Pavese stated teachers have master's degrees.

Supervisor Rieber asked if anyone from the public would like to be heard on this matter. The following public comments were made:

Paul Walsh of Rock Hill stated that there is no employee manual. He said that when he first started his business, things were good, but as his workforce changed their views changed. Years ago there were better work ethics than there are today. There is an

opportunity to look at the whole system and make changes to the whole system. He said there is no incentive, because they just come to work and know that at the end of the year they can take 14 days off.

Supervisor Rieber said that in the modern world sick and vacation days are all the same.

A resident whose name was not stated asked if there has been a survey done in the surrounding communities to see what other employees are getting in other local governments. Fourteen days sounds like a lot to him.

Supervisor Rieber said that this was not the intent of this law. Fourteen is what they get now. No survey was done.

David Bunce of Monticello stated, as an employee, that the Highway Department is out there in the cold weather or the Sewer Department with what they deal with they catch colds easier than most, some bad flus and stuff so they are out a couple of days. He was out when he needed back surgery. Fourteen days when it comes down to the environments the employees works is not a lot of days.

Supervisor Rieber clarified that this proposed law has no effect on the Water & Sewer Department or Highway Department because they have a Collective Bargaining Agreement. It really only effects a few employees.

The same resident who did not state his name asked if there were a maximum number of days an employee can accrue?

Supervisor Rieber said the maximum number of days is 150 not payable upon retirement. They must use it or lose it.

The same resident who did not state his name asked if they were required to bring a doctor's note.

Supervisor Rieber said the Department Heads have the right to require the doctor's note from the employee if they feel there is an abuse of time.

Paul Walsh of Rock Hill asked if there was a policy saying they have to bring a note after 3 days of absence?

Town Clerk Calhoun stated that is how it has always been.

Paul Walsh thinks that our Town has the strongest workforce around and we need to keep the Town strong.

Supervisor Rieber said we are not changing anything with this law, this is to clarify how sick time is accrued, which is just clarifying what has been done for forty years. Nothing

is changing and we are not giving anybody anything extra. Discussing sick leave and benefits is a topic for the collective bargaining negotiations. This is not the forum for it. This is just clarifying what employees with less than one year of service are entitled to. This topic came up because a new employee needed a day off. If an employee has been in service for six months, they should be able to take a ½ day off for a doctor's appointment and not take money away from their family. This is the only reason this is before the Town Board at this time.

Attorney Mednick said we are just clarifying how the sick days accrue.

Paul Walsh asked if there was any incentive for the employees to make sure they show up every day.

Supervisor Rieber said they can hire the employee on a probationary period.

Councilman Mace thinks that they should start the new employee out slow and build up, like what is done with the health insurance by contributing 10%. There are many people that he has spoken with regarding this matter who were very surprised about how many sick days the employees received. This does cost money to the Town and its taxpayers to lose that productivity.

Supervisor Rieber said it is also important that new employees be heard to train and learn their new job.

Councilman Sush asked if this has to be negotiated.

Supervisor Rieber said no, it is work rules, everybody that is not covered by the collective bargaining agreements.

Attorney Mednick stated that the local law before us only addresses Section 48 and how the 14 sick days are accrued, nothing about reducing the number of sick days that can be accrued. The law is just refining the sick time accrual process. You must work 30 days to earn one sick day. If you are reducing days or changing something significant, you must prepare a new local law that would have to be re-introduced and published.

Paul Walsh said that there is an opportunity to readjust this and make a stepping stone for only the new employees.

Supervisor Rieber said if the Town is going to change the number of sick days it should be re-published and left on the table for a while.

Councilman Mace asked if someone will be tracking the accrual of time and if it should be part of this local law before us tonight?

Supervisor Rieber said that should be addressed separately.

The same resident who did not state his name asked to clarify 30 days. Is that a month?

Councilman Mace said it should be two pay periods? Further discussion ensued regarding how the sick time should be calculated.

After an opportunity for all persons to be heard Supervisor Rieber entertained a motion that the public hearing be closed.

A motion to close the Public Hearing at 7:49 PM was made by Councilman Briggs and seconded by Councilman Sush.

### **REGULAR MEETING – CALL TO ORDER**

Supervisor Rieber opened the meeting at 7:50 PM with the Pledge to the Flag. He welcomed the Participation in Government Students to the meeting.

### **APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

On a motion made by Councilman Briggs and seconded by Councilman Mace the minutes of the September 02, 2014 Regular Town Board Meeting were approved as presented.

### **PUBLIC COMMENT:**

Paul Walsh of Rock Hill stated that Betty Fraser passed away last Saturday at 98 years of age. Mrs. Fraser was the mother of the Town's former Highway Superintendent, Richard Fraser. The Town Board acknowledged her passing.

Phil Winograd of Monticello commented on the Monticello Central School District Overcharge.

### **CORRESPONDENCE:**

Supervisor Rieber reported on correspondence that was sent or received as follows:

1. Letter dated 08/29/2014 from Erin O'Dell-Keller, Manager, Outreach and Education of State of New York Department of Public Service regarding Lifeline Discount Telephone Service.
2. Letter dated 08/27/2014 from Rebecca S. Crist, Division of Environmental Permits of NYSDEC to Emerald Green Property Owners Association, Inc. regarding Treasure Lake Notice of Complete Application.
3. Letter dated 08/28/2014 from Sean Menon of Leonia, New Jersey to Town Board regarding a ZBA extension for construction on his property, SBL# 36.-8-1, on Wanaksink Lake. The Town is unable to extend the ZBA approval since the time period for the extensions have passed. There is nothing that the Town Board can do for him to extend the approvals.

4. Memo dated 08/28/2014 from Monica Farquhar Brennan of Sullivan County Office of Risk Management and Insurance to Supervisor Rieber regarding Workers Compensation Apportionment for Fiscal Year January 1, 2015 – December 31, 2015. The Town's share is \$266,913.00.
5. E-mail dated 09/11/2014 from Gary D. Silver, Esq. to Supervisor Rieber and Attorney Mednick advising that his client, Veria Lifestyles are not interested in the creation of a Lighting District on Kutsher Road.
6. E-mail dated 09/09/2014 from Gary D. Silver, Esq. to Code Enforcement Officer Logan E. Ottino regarding the Veria Lifestyles Demolition. There was a delay in the demolition, due to a stop work order that was issued by the NYSDOL, which has since been lifted. He was advised the debris at the corner of Kutsher Road and Old Liberty Road was removed and they are proceeding with demolition.

**AGENDA ITEMS:**

**1. DISCUSSION: PROPOSED LOCAL LAW #5 – SICK TIME ACCRUAL FOR NEW EMPLOYEES**

There was further discussion regarding this matter. Attorney Mednick said that if an employee starts on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of the month does he get a day off two days later? The answer is no according to the way the law is written. An employee shall accrue the first sick day after one month of employment and days will continue to accrue pursuant to this section each month thereafter. The Town Attorney was directed to draft a new local law to reduce the number of sick days for the first year of employment for all new employees hired. This law will also clarify how the sick time is to be accrued and credited for those employees. The Town Board also discussed how sick, vacation and personal time is monitored and tracked. This needs to be converted into a payroll system for proper accounting. There was no action taken on this proposed law. Attorney Mednick will revise the law and re-introduce it at the next Town Board Meeting at which time the Board can consider for said action.

**2. SHRED DAY EVENT-SATURDAY, OCTOBER 11<sup>TH</sup>, 2014, 9 AM TO 12 PM**

Councilman Mace announced that the Town will be co-sponsoring with the Catskill Hudson Bank for the Fall Shredding Day Event. The event will take place on Saturday, October 11th, 2014 from 9am until Noon. Councilman Mace arranged the date and time with the company that the Town has previously used "Confidential Shred".

**The Following Resolution Was Duly Adopted: Res. No. 232 of the Year 2014.**

Resolved, that the Town of Thompson enter into a joint agreement with Catskill Hudson Bank to co-sponsor a Community Shredding Day Event to be held on Saturday, October 11th, 2014 from 9 am to 12 pm. Further Be It Resolved, that the Town shall contribute half the cost towards the event. Supervisor Rieber will do the required public notice to inform our residents of this service.

**3. FALL CLEANUP EVENT – SATURDAY OCTOBER 11<sup>TH</sup>, 2014 THROUGH SATURDAY, OCTOBER 18<sup>TH</sup>, 2014**

Town Clerk Calhoun is recommending that the Town set a date for the Fall Cleanup Program, Saturday, October 11th thru Saturday, October 18<sup>th</sup>. The Town will continue to follow the same procedures as last year with the residents bringing their clean up materials directly to the landfill. They are still required to obtain a permit from the Town Clerk's Office. The limit per permit will be 500lbs, which has increased from last year. Town Clerk said that these dates would allow Town residents one entire week to participate in the program, which also includes two Saturday's since the landfill has limited weekend hours.

**5. EXTEND CONTRACT WITH MEDIA SOLSTICE FOR TOWN WEBSITE**

Supervisor Rieber said that he received a notification from Media Solstice Marking & PR regarding the renewal of the Towns maintenance agreement for the Town Website, which cost the Town approximately \$2,300.00 a year. Town Clerk Calhoun contacted Jessica Gardner, President/CEO of Media Solstice to obtain a copy of the new maintenance agreement. Ms. Gardner contacted Town Clerk Calhoun back via email

and advised that the regular 6-month web updating maintenance fee was recently received and the Town is covered through February. Town Clerk Calhoun said that according to this information there is no action required at this time. Town Clerk Calhoun also reported on the scheduled website training this Thursday.

**6. AWARD RFP'S FOR SANITIZING OF CHAIRS & CLEANING CARPETS IN TOWN HALL**

Supervisor Rieber reported that he received two proposals for carpet cleaning and chair sanitizing. The first proposal was received from Harry O's, Inc., Monticello, NY in the amount of \$1,998.75. The second proposal was received from Duraclean, Cochection, NY in the amount of \$1,336.84. Supervisor Rieber said that both contractors are qualified he is recommending that the proposal be awarded to Duraclean whose proposal is the lowest.

**The Following Resolution Was Duly Adopted: Res. No. 235 of the Year 2014.**

Resolved, that Supervisor William J. Rieber, Jr. hereby be authorized to accept the proposal of Duraclean in the amount of \$1,336.84 for the sanitizing of chairs and cleaning of the carpets in the Town Hall. Further Be It Resolved, that the Town Clerk is hereby authorized to send notification to both contractors.
