RECONVENED TOWN BOARD MEETING

Supervisor Rieber opened the reconvened meeting at 12:30 PM. Supervisor Rieber announced that due to the outbreak of Coronavirus (COVID-19) the meeting will be held via Videoconferencing and streamed live on the Zoom app and Facebook Live, which is accessible to the public and is also being recorded for full transcription purposes should it be required.

Supervisor Rieber advised that the prior Regular Town Board Meeting of 04/21/2020 was recessed until this meeting for the purpose of reviewing and discussing the Insurance Proposals for the Town. Also to take action to approve one of the Proposals to renew the Town's Insurance Coverage. Notice of said meeting was posted on the Town website.

DISCUSS & APPROVE INSURANCE PROPOSALS FOR THE TOWN: 05/01/2020 INSURANCE COVERAGE RENEWAL

Supervisor Rieber referred to a letter dated 04/27/2020 from Nuchem E. Lebovits, VP of Lebaum Company, Inc. regarding Insurance Proposals for the Town. They submitted requests from (6) various underwriters that write insurance for public entities. There was only (1) proposal provided by New York Municipal Insurance Reciprocal (NYMIR) for a total premium + fees in the amount of \$167,590.31. Responses from the other carriers were provided and most of them declined to quote. A copy of the most recent loss runs dated 03/06/2020 was provided. Councilman Mace had several questions regarding claims listed on the loss runs and claim reserves, which were discussed. There was also discussion regarding the Highway Department Garage Fire as well as other open claims listed on the loss runs. Comptroller DeMarmels advised that there are separate insurance policies for Cyber and Crime Coverage. A copy of the proposal and cover letter will be on file in the Town Clerk's Office. Action to approve a budget transfer/amendment to cover the additional premium and to approve the (NYMIR) proposal presented was taken as follows:
